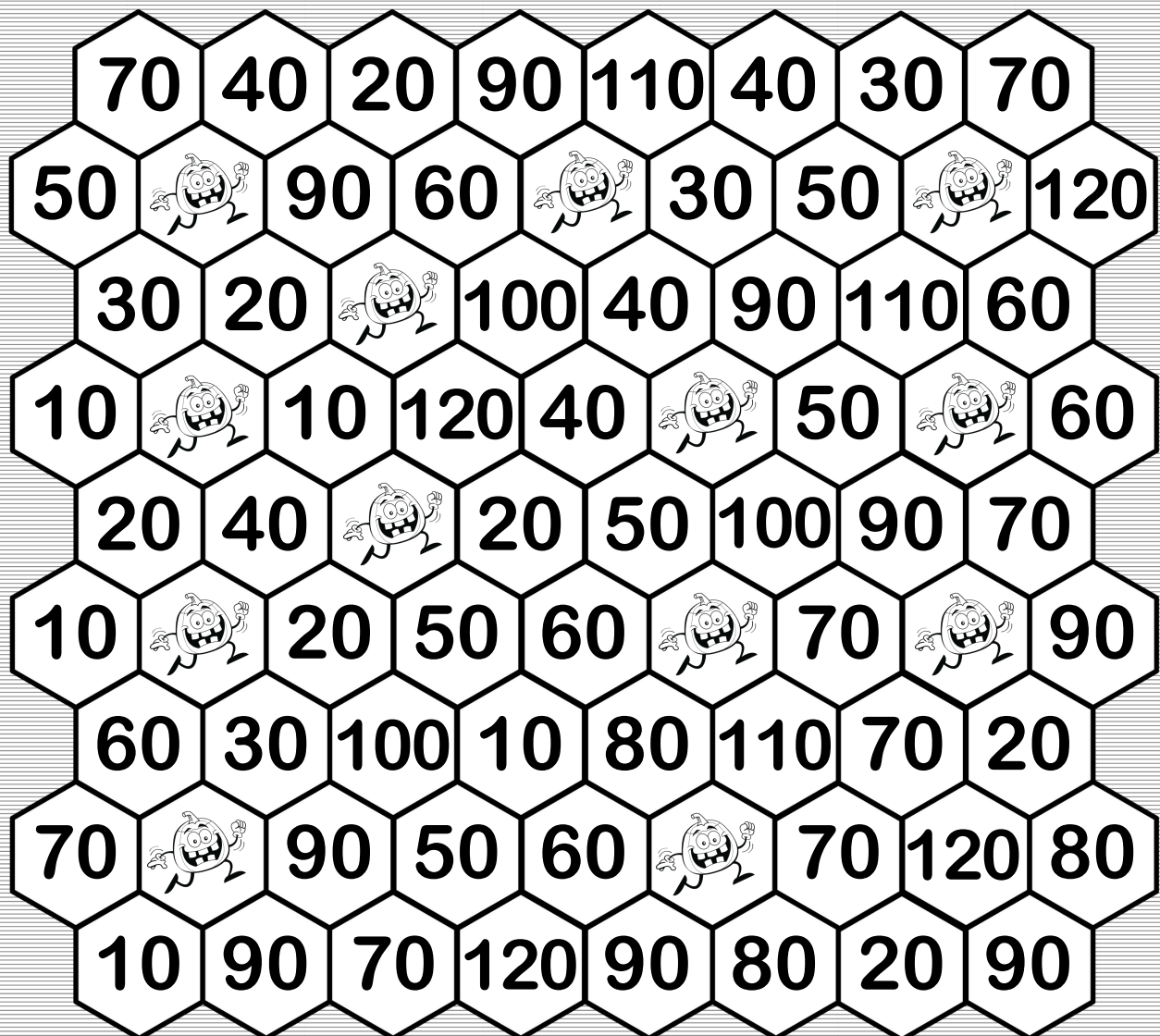


# Capture the Pumpkin

Multiply by 10

## Instructions

Players roll 1 or 2 dice and multiply the numbers. Whoever has the largest product goes first. Players then take turns rolling 2 dice and multiplying it by 10 and covering a product. The goal is to trap a pumpkin. Play continues until all pumpkins are either captured or there is no way to capture a pumpkin. Whoever captures the most pumpkins wins. Or, just play together and try to capture all the pumpkins. Remember that multiplying by 11 makes it 110 and multiplying by 12 can be  $(11 \times 10) + (1 \times 10)$  which is 120.

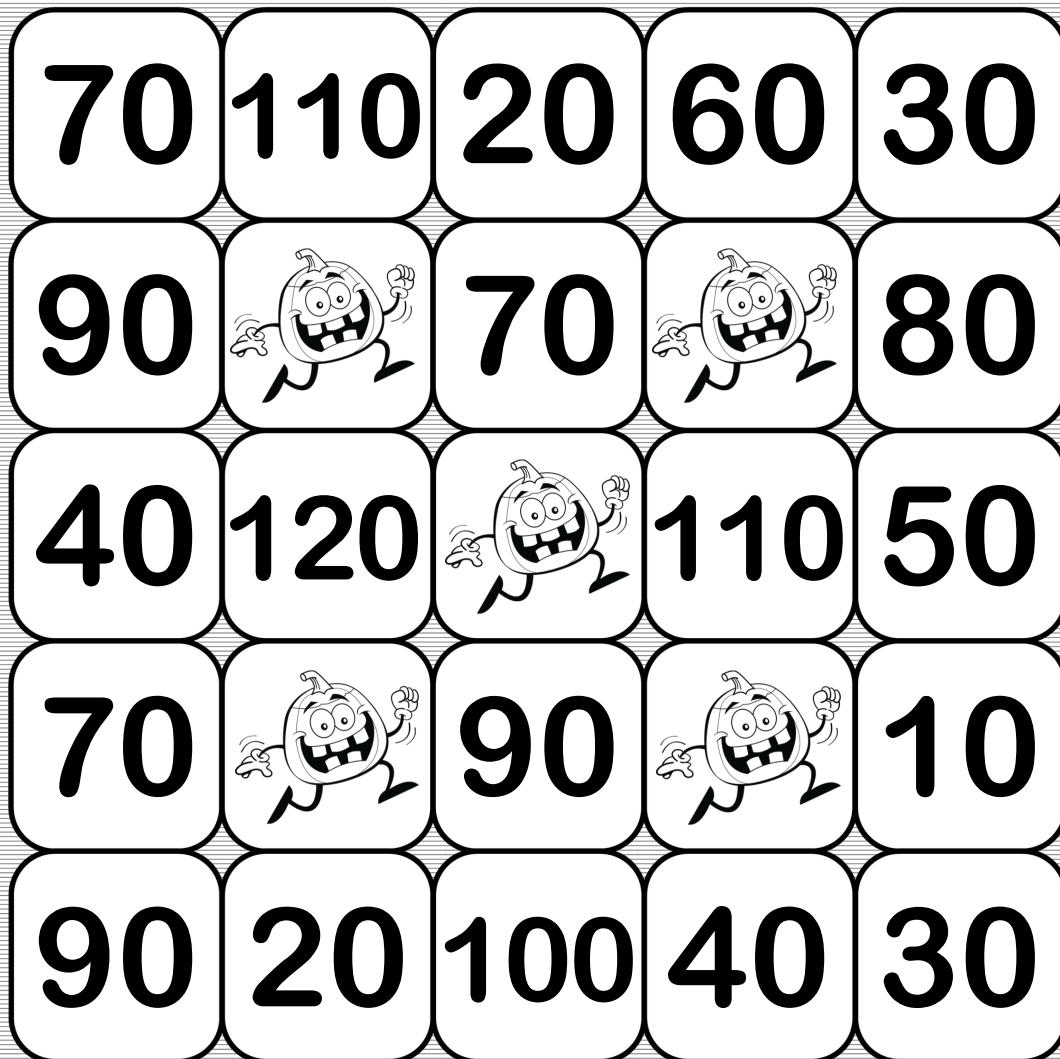


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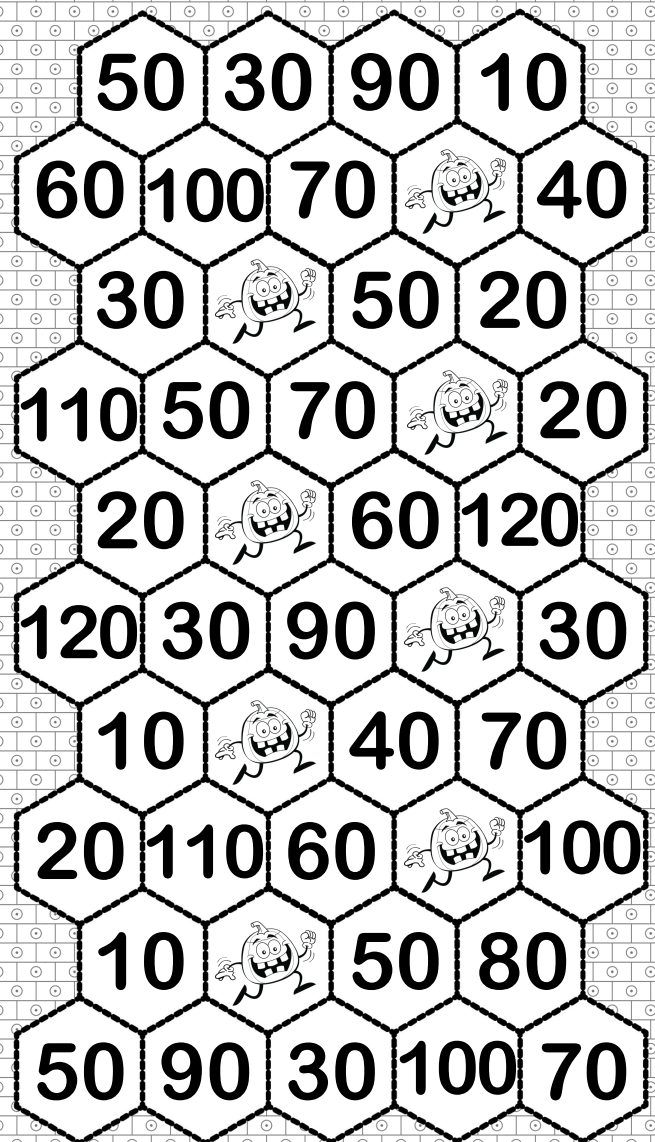
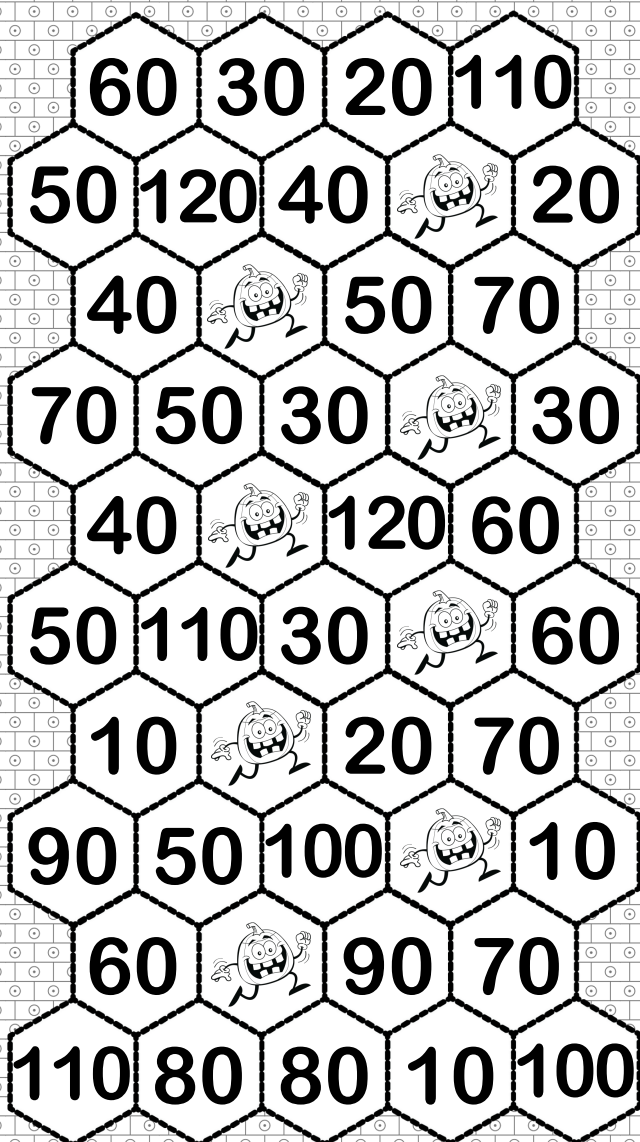
