




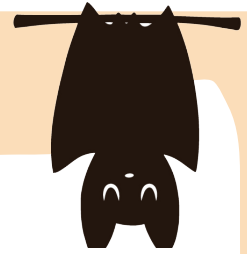
FIVE LITTLE BATS IN THE MIDNIGHT SKY

So they all flew home to their cozy nest.**

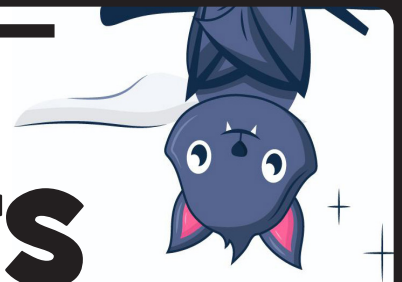
**With wings tucked tight, they snuggled in deep,
